MTH 101 – ALGEBRA FOR COLLEGE STUDENTS

Due to the University's closure for Hurricane Irma and resulting recovery period, the grading policy for this course has changed. Exam dates have also been adjusted in accordance to the new academic calendar published on September 20, 2017. All other policies set forth in the previously published syllabus for this course will remain in effect.

GRADING POLICY: Final grades for the course will be based on a **total of 750 points**.

EXAMS (600 points): There will be four 50-minute exams during the semester. Each exam will be worth 150 points, contributing 600 points to the total.

HOMEWORK (100 points): Graded homework assignments and periodic quizzes are to be completed in MyMathLab. The student is responsible for checking MyMathLab frequently for upcoming deadlines for these assignments. The work completed in MyMathLab will contribute 100 points to the total.

END OF COURSE ASSESSMENT (50 points): An end of course assessment will be a comprehensive exam. This exam will be assigned as an online test in MyMathLab. The test will have 30 questions and you will be allowed 90 minutes to complete the test. This will be a timed assessment and will be worth 50 points.
